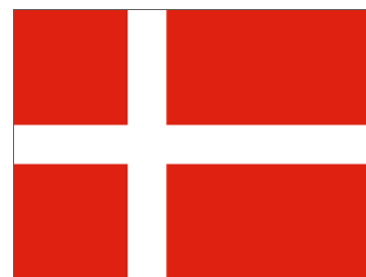
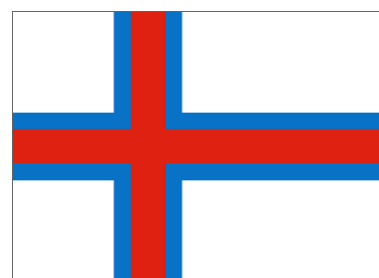
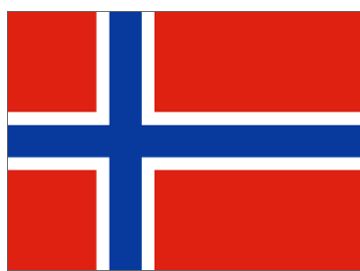

5. Official venue of arrival and departure for the teams

Each delegation must bring the following to the Preliminary inquiry:

- Passport for identity
- CEV CH-05bis form
- Doctor authorisation if medicine are used
- Sample of each colour of uniform shirt and uniform shorts of captain and libero
- Receipt of financial matters paid to the Swedish Volleyball Association

8. Financial matters
